



### Salem Apple Butter Festival Senior King and Queen 2022 - Mr. and Mrs. Gary Martin Sr.

Gary was born in Clarksburg, West Virginia and raised in Marion County around the Mannington area until his family moved to Salem when he was a sophomore in high school, completing his high school education and graduating from Salem High School in 1967. He worked part time during high school at the Salem Herald doing typesetting and printing. He attended Glenville State College for one year. He then went to work in the printing business for the Havre De Grace Record in Maryland. He was drafted during tenure thee enlisting instead in order to enter under a delay program. Gary is a Vietnam Veteran having served in the Army for one year with the 1st Platoon, 560th Military Police stationed in Pleiku, Republic of Vietnam. Completing his military obligation, he was honorably discharged.

Gary attends the Salem Seventh Day Baptist Church where he is a deacon, and he has been a long time Sabbath School teacher. Gary was married in 1970 to the former Rebecca Hurley. They have 4 children and 8 grandchildren.

Returning to Salem following his military discharge he opened ProComPrint which he operated approximately 7 years. He then went to work for Yates Printing in Fairmont, West Virginia, then for PDQ Print shop in Clarksburg, Finally ending up a manager of the commercial printing division of Clarksburg Publishing company from 1980 to 2001. Gary bought and eventually owned and operated his own printing shop known as Clarksburg Printing, LLC which he closed in 2016.

In 1999 Gary, Sr. along with his son Gary, Jr. opened Salem East Gate Center. The center now includes Family Dollar, Super Wok Chinese Restaurant, and EastGate Used Car Lot.

Over the years Gary has been involved in and served in many capacities with area organizations- American V.A.L.U.E. (Volunteer Americans Living Untied Examples), Clarksburg development Corporation, the first Clarksburg Convention and Visitors bureau the combined Bridgeport Clarksburg Convention and Visitors bureau and the first Main Street Program established in West Virginia in Clarksburg. Gary was honored to receive Citizen of the year for Salem Area Chamber of Commerce in 2009. other organizations served include Unity Way, The Art Center, Harrison County Chamber, Salem Chamber, Greater Clarksburg Associates, State board Miss WV Scholarship pageant. Jerry Lewis Telethon and Foster Grant Parents Program. Gary was honored to serve as co-chairman with his father -in-law Dr. K. D. Hurly on Salem's. Bicentennial Committe, Gary is currently on the Fort New Salem Board and a member of the Salem Area Chamber of Commerce.

Gary served as General chairman of the Salem Apple Butter Festival for 30 years giving up that position for the 2022 Festival.

Rebecca (Hurley) martin was born in Los Angeles, California and moved to Salem, West Virginia when she was 3 years old. She moved with her family so her father K.D. Hurley could be President of Salem College. He held that position for 22 years. Rebecca graduated from Salem High School in 1967. Rebecca graduated from Salem College in 1972 with a Bachelor of Science degree. Her field of study was Elementary Education.

Rebecca attends Salem Seventh Day Baptist Chruch where she was been a member for over 50 years and where she served as a trustee. She has been married to Gary for 52 years and have 4 children and 8 grandchildren.

Rebecca taught for 28 years at Greenbrier Elementary in Doddridge County and 11 years at Doddridge Elementary, teaching kindergarten at that school She retired after 40 years in 2015 and has been on the substitute list for Doddridge Elementary ever since. 


# Salem Apple Butter Festival Senior King and Queen 2002 Mr. and Mrs. W. Fred (Venita) Zinn
