Salem Apple Butter Festival Senior King and Queen 2023 Mr. and Mrs. Glenn (Mary) Davis



Glenn and Mary Davis will serve as king and queen for the 2023 Apple Butter Festival. They are very honored by this selection as both trace their families, history back 7 Generations in Salem. Mary's lineage back to Samuel Fitz Randolph while Glenn traces his ancestry to Nathan Davis both of these gentlemen were settlers and landowners in New Salem, Virginia.

While Glenn was born in Parkersburg, WV and Mary was born in Trieste Italy both were raised and educated in the Salem Community. They attended Van Horn Grade School and Salem High School where Glenn acquired the nickname "Poker" as he was most commonly known. He graduated in 1964 and Mary graduated with the class of '68. Both are proud alumni of THE SALEM COLLEGE.

Poker graduated with a BS Degree in 1969, Mary completing her Banking Degree at the Salem College Clarksburg Campus in 1988. Following Poker's graduation, they were married and Glenn was drafted into the Army beginning a 25-year career. During the next 7 years they were stationed in Texas, and Georgia, where their daughter Heather was born at Ft. Benning. They then had a 3-year tour in Germany where two of those years being in the di-


vided and walled city of Berlin. They returned to the US where they spent 2½ years at Ft. Ord, California. Due to Glenn's parents aging and health issues, he transferred to the Army Active Reserve and they returned to the Salem area in 1977. Glenn served as Assistant Dean of Admissions for Salem College Clarksburg campus and Mary began her banking career at Union National Bank in Clarksburg.

In 1983 Glenn was selected for the US Army Oklahoma University's Physician Assistant Program and went back on active duty at Fort Sam Houston, Texas for the next two years and Mary stayed in Salem to allow Heather to continue her schooling there. Following Heather's graduation from Liberty High School in 1989 Glenn and Mary relocated to Wilmington, Delaware where Glenn took a position with the E.I. Dupont company and Mary continued her banking career at Beneficial National Bank. In December of 1990 Glenn was activated for Operation Desert Storm serving with the 155th Mech Infantry battalion of the 155th Armored Brigade Calvary division, serving until April of 1991.

In 1994 Glenn joined the medical group of Doctors for Emergency Services which provided emergency room coverage in the Wilmington and Elkton Maryland area. During this time, the Davies took up the hobby of Civil War reenacting portraying both a Union and Confederate Surgeon and Mary established her sewing business specializing in Victorian era clothing for women and children. Glenn retired from DFES in 2001 and went to work as a contract medical officer for the Peace Corps and US State Department with assignments in Tashkent Uzbekistan, Lome Togo, in West Africa, and Dhaka, Bangladesh.


Anticipating retirement back to the Salem area, in 2006 Glenn and Mary purchased a money pit at the mouth of Raccoon Run, a suburb of Salem. Following Mary's retirement in 2007 as Vice President of Operations for Sun National Bank in Vineland, New Jersey, they returned to Raccoon Run where they currently reside.

Since returning to the Salem area, Glenn and Mary have been active as interpreters and living historians at Fort New Salem and Glenn served a term on the Board of Directors for the fort. Glenn portrays his fourth great grandfather Nathan with Mary portraying the life of Nathan's wife Anne. Both remain active in the Friends of Fort New Salem group and assist at the Fort whenever possible.



They also continue to be members of the Fort Delaware Historical Society, and Glenn is a permanent member of the Society of Civil war surgeons. Mary has been a lifelong member of the Baptist Church where she has held numerous positions. Currently, Mary is the secretary of the Board of Trustees for the church and is president of the SBC American Baptist Women's Ministries. She also currently serves as State President for West Virginia ABWM. Mary has volunteered and serves on numerous committees for the community of Salem. Their daughter Heather resides in Pelham Alabama and has three daughters.




"2023 GRAND MARSHAL"
