Money for the cash prizes for the judged categories have been raised by Oma's Hobby Hideaway and the Millennium Quilt Guild. The People's Choice cash award was donated by Robert Huffman of Bristol, WV.

All entries should have a hanging sleeve. Sleeves can be made by cutting a strip of fabric 8 ½ inches wide and equal to the width of you quilt. Sew the raw edges together to make a tube. Hand sew to the top of the back of the quilt. Leave ends open to allow a pole to run thru to hang the quilt for display.

Each category will be judged and a first, second, and third place ribbon will be awarded.
